What to do in Historic Lockport...

Spend an hour, a day or a weekend in Lockport, Illinois on the I & M Canal

Lockport has been called the best preserved Canal Town in the United States. It has a Nationally Registered Historic District filled with beautiful examples of 19th century architecture, four fine museums, visitor oriented exhibits, the I & M Canal and Donnelley Trail, award winning restaurants, unique shops and recreational opportunities. It is amazing to see so many interesting sites packed into a small historic district. Everything is within walking distance of convenient parking at 9th Street just west of State Street. One can also enter the parking lot from State Street going west at 10th Street.

To See the Sites, Start at the Historic Gaylord Building - located at 8th Street and the I & M Canal.

You can walk from the South Public Landing Parking Lot along the Donnelley Canal Trail under the 9th Street bridge to the Visitor Center in the Gaylord Building. Pick up Visitor Brochures - especially the Self Guided Walking Tour brochure which contains a map of the Historic District. Restrooms are located here. Take time to see the exhibits. Notice the tempting Public Landing Restaurant, it is open for



Limestone entrance to the South Public Landing Parking Lot off of 9th Street in the Heart of the Historic District. From this location one can walk to all visitor sites, restaurants, shops and trails.

Lunch and Dinner Tuesday through Sunday. Walk east to the Will County Historical Society Museum at 8th and State, or walk south from the Gaylord

Building through the Lincoln Landing, under the 9th Street bridge to the Norton Building to visit the Illinois State Museum Lockport Gallery. Lockport Museums are located in Historic Buildings within the Historic District. All of the sites are within walking distance from the South Public Landing Parking Lot. Learn about the current exhibits on page 2.

Go Straight To Restaurants and Shops...

Walk east from the Parking Lot to State Street. Find restaurants and shops from 8th and State Street to 12th and State Street also on 8th and 9th Streets near State Street. Many shops are unique and specialize in specific fields - such as Thimbles. It stocks a large variety of fine quilting fabrics in a rainbow of colors.

Explore the Downtown and enjoy the neighborhood of 1890's buildings with fancy cornices, tall windows and brick and limestone construction. Many were built after the Lockport Fire of 1895. Stop for a glass of wine at William Alexander Wine Studio or buy homemade candies at Hollingworth Candies - taste English toffee at its best.

Dining in Lockport is a great experience. Whether you want ice cream, a sandwich, pizza, an elegant Italian lunch or a five course award winning dinner, you can find it in the Historic District in Lockport. Bon appetit!

Sleepers Base Ball Club of Lockport recreates the national pastime as it was played before the Civil War. HISTORIC DELLWOOD PARK

Built in the early 1900's as a 150 acre amusement park with extensive playing fields, trails, picnic areas, creek and bluffs. Originally a boathouse, a dam, and a dance hall were located there.

This park is still the center of sports, activities and events including the 4th of July Celebration and Civil War Days reenactment. Dellwood Park is located at State Street and Woods Drive just south of Lockport's historic downtown.

The Historic Illinois & Michigan Canal and Donnelley Trail is located just west of and parallel to State Street in Lockport. It can be accessed from the South Public Landing Parking Lot at 9th Street west of State Street, or west of the 13th Street Train Station or west of the 8th Street Parking Lot. The trail connects Lockport to the south to Dellwood Park and Joliet and to the north to Lemont. As you go north, you should cross over the bridge at 135th Street and then get back on the trail to go north to Lemont.

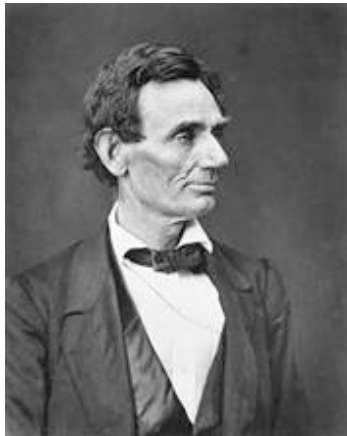
